

# Blockhead Nouveau Shiraz 2021 Barossa

## The Wine

Crafted to achieve a wine that is unmistakably Barossa in generosity of flavours and aromas.

This elegant and lighter style of Shiraz boosts in colour and flavours, showcasing the distinct softness and drinkability of the blockhead range.

Nouveau Shiraz is a feminine twist of a lighter style that will appeal to those looking a much more approachable wine that can also be enjoyed chilled from the fridge or just with ice during the hot summer days.

## Bouquet

Bouquet: Lifted aromas of fresh blueberries, raspberry compote and an elusive violet perfume fills the glass.

## Palate

Palate: The sweet fruit entry explodes with intense raspberries and blackberries with a subtle note of candy. Medium bodied and vibrant, yet round and unctuous, the fresh fruit expression continues right through to the finely textured finish.

## The Vineyards

The fruit used to create Blockhead Shiraz was sourced primarily from select family owned Barossa vineyards on the black, biscay soils of Central Barossa and the red brown earth of the Northern Barossa Valley.

## The Inspiration

The original European settlers in the Barossa township of Tanunda, where St Hallett winery resides, were known as Blockheads. The origins of the Blockhead name are most commonly linked to their stoic, square jawed character and dedication to the land. At the winery, and amongst their descendants, the title is worn as a badge of honour.

The Blockhead range is designed to tell their story to a new generation, combining 74 years of St Hallett winemaking expertise with the fruitful drinkability of contemporary Australian Shiraz.
