The Wine

Colour

Deep crimson with intense violet hues.

Bouquet

Black cherry, spiced plum skin and dried herbs all contribute refined layers of complexity to the nose.

Palate

Complex flavours of black cherry and blackberry meld into a plush mid palate of toasted clove, cedar and dried herbs. An elegant wine of great restraint and texture, finishing with a fine directional tannin.

Cellaring

4-8 years

The Vintage

The 2019 vintage was one of the driest we have experienced. Below average winter rainfall, coupled with a dry spring and summer resulted in naturally lower yields across most vineyards. These conditions resulted in exceptionally rich and concentrated wines, although low in quantity.

The Vineyards

Grapes for Garden of Eden are sourced exclusively from the high elevation Eden Valley. This results in pretty red fruit characters, spice and fine tannin structure. This region of Barossa has always been important for St Hallett and has contributed to most vintages of the flagship Old Block Shiraz
