The Wine

Colour

Deep red w/ purple hues.

Bouquet

Expressive notes of mulberry, cherry, exotic spice and a touch of mint.

Palate

The palate opens with lifted red fruits and sweet cherry over toasted spice with dark chocolate and fresh cherry stone in the background. An elegant and finely textured medium bodied wine with layers complex fruit supported by supple tannins.

Cellaring

4-8 years

The Vintage

Early in the season dry conditions were coupled with frequent frosts, followed by heavy winds that affected flowering and fruit set. Fortunately, the ripening period was remarkably mild and a sudden rain event in early February breathed some life into the struggling vines and saw them flourish right through to the harvest period. The 2020 vintage was one of our lowest yields on record, but the quality was exceptional, particularly in Northern Barossa and Eden Valley.

The Vineyards

Grapes for Garden of Eden are sourced exclusively from the high elevation Eden Valley. This results in pretty red fruit characters, spice and fine tannin structure. This region of Barossa has always been important for St Hallett and has contributed to most vintages of the flagship Old Block Shiraz

Try with grilled lamb cutlets, broccolini and salsa verde.
