The Wine

Colour

Deep red w/ purple hues.

Bouquet

Raspberry, berry coulis and dried herbs all contribute refined layers of complexity to the nose

Palate

Complex flavours of red berry and mulberry meld into a plush mid palate of Christmas spice, cedar and dried herbs. An elegant wine of great restraint and texture, finishing with a fine directional tannin.

Cellaring

4-8 years

The Vintage

With excellent winter rains, near average rainfall and a full moisture profile in the soil, the vines flourished throughout the season. An excellent fruit set in the spring followed by a warm dry summer preceded mild vintage conditions and ensured the grapes achieved their optimal phenolic maturity. This is an exceptional vintage, producing balanced wines with great fruit intensity and concentration.

The Vineyards

Grapes for Garden of Eden are sourced exclusively from the high elevation Eden Valley. This results in pretty red fruit characters, spice and fine tannin structure. This region of Barossa has always been important for St Hallett and has contributed to most vintages of the flagship Old Block Shiraz

Food Match

Try with grilled lamb cutlets, broccolini and salsa verde.
